- THE SOLAR SYSTEM

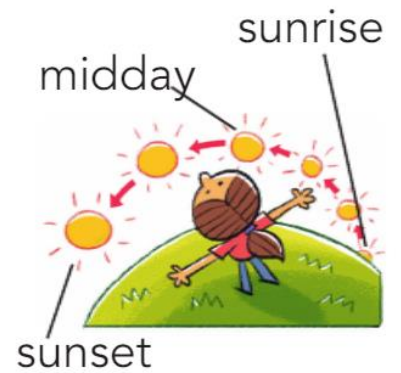

| The Sun is a star. It gives light and heat. |
| Planets orbit stars. THE EARTH is our planet. |
| Satellites orbit planets. THE MOON is our satellite. |



- ROTATION

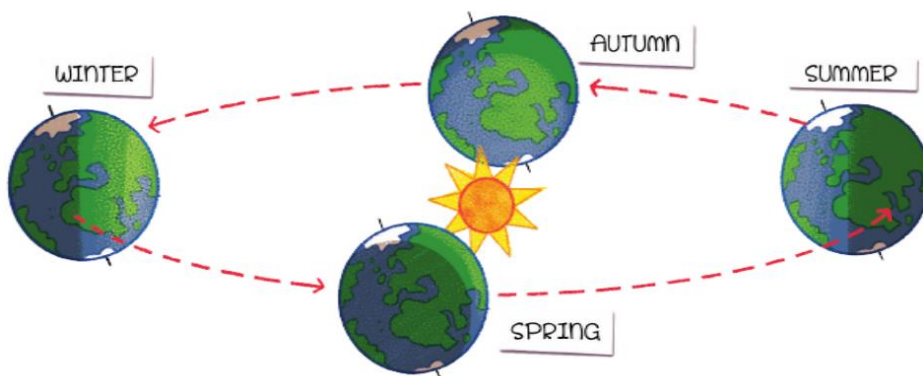

| ROTATION: the Earth spins on its own axis. |
| One rotation takes 24 hours. It creates DAYS and NIGHTS. |
| SUNRISE : we first see the Sun. |
| MIDDAY : The Sun is directly overhead. |
| SUNSET: The Sun is disappearing. |



- SEASONS

A complete orbit of the Earth around the Sun takes 365 days (1 year). It gives us the seasons.



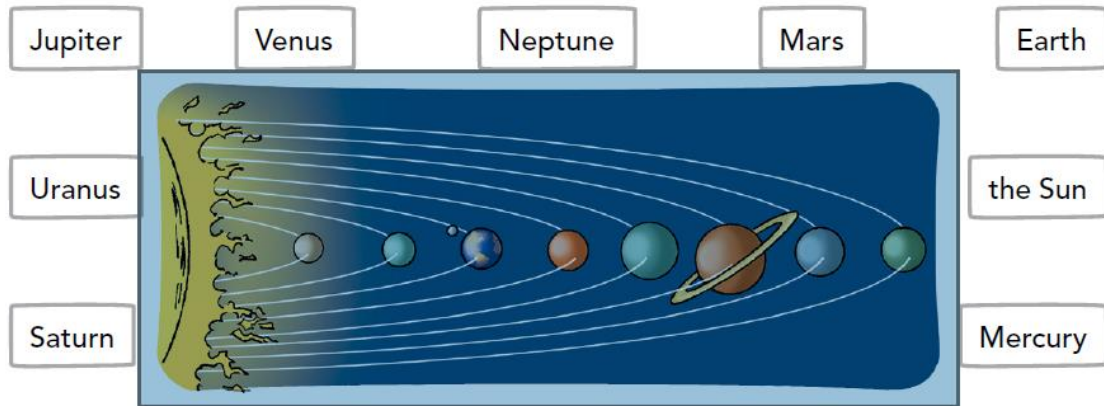
- THE PHASES OF THE MOON

The Moon orbits around the Earth.
We use different parts of the Moon. They are called PHASES of the MOON.
